MEDICAID, PCN AND CHIP DENTAL BENEFITS

Traditional Medicaid: adults twenty-one years of age and older aged, blind, disabled, non-pregnant

- X-rays
- Fillings
- Root canal treatment for permanent teeth (excluding second and third molars)
- Simple tooth extractions

Traditional Medicaid: children birth through twenty years of age and pregnant women of any age.

- Two dental examinations a year with x-rays and cleaning
- Topical fluoride applications and sealant
- Fillings
- Root canal treatment (excludes second and third molars for pregnant women)
- Orthodontia in cases of severe malocclusion (prior approval required)
- General anesthesia (prior approval required)

Non-Traditional Medicaid: non-pregnant adults nineteen through sixty-four years of age

- Emergency examination for pain or tooth infection
- X-rays to diagnose an infected tooth
- Extraction of an infected tooth
- There are no co-payments for dental services which are benefits of Medicaid

Primary Care Network (PCN) Dental Benefits Adults nineteen years of age and older

- One examination with x-rays and cleaning every six months
- Topical fluoride treatments
- Resin (tooth colored) fillings for front teeth
- Amalgam (silver) fillings for back teeth
- Emergency examination for pain or tooth infection
- Extractions (excluding impacted teeth)

Those enrolled in the PCN are required to make a co-insurance payment of 10% of the cost of each procedure performed at each visit. Dental services for those on the PCN are provided only by dentists who are Medicaid providers.

Children's Health Insurance Plan Dental Benefits (CHIP) Birth through 18 years of age

- Two dental examinations a year
- X-rays and cleanings
- Sealants and topical fluoride applications
- Fillings and stainless steel crowns
- Space maintainer Extractions
- Pulpotomy/Pulpal Therapy

CHIP Plan A pays 100% for examinations, x-rays, cleanings, sealants and fluoride applications. There is a \$3.00 co-pay for fillings, stainless steel crowns, space maintainers, extractions and pulpotomies on CHIP Plan A. CHIP Plan B pays 100% for examinations, x-rays, cleanings, sealants and fluoride applications. Plan B pays 80% of the charge for fillings, stainless steel crowns, space maintainers, extractions and pulpotomies.
